The 22nd International Congress of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics (ICTAM 2008) 及澳洲學術研究機關參訪

台灣大學機械系/工工所 吳文方 撰 09/10/2008

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一、出國事由

國際理論及應用力學研討會(International Congress of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics,簡稱 ICTAM)為目前世界上有關理論及應用力學方面(包括固體力學及流體 力學)最具知名度、也最具國際學術權威的研討會,它濫觴於 1924 年,歷史十分悠久。該研討會主要由國際理論及應用力學組織(The International Union of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics,簡稱 IUTAM)所主導,而 IUTAM 也是國際科學總會(International Council for Science,簡稱 ICSU)的團體會員之一。ICTAM 除前七屆外,自 1952 年(第 八屆)至今,每四年在世界各國輪流主辦,迄今已有八十年的歷史。ICTAM 上屆(第二十一屆)會議於 2004 年在波蘭華沙舉辦,本屆(第二十二屆,亦簡稱為 ICTAM 2008)則於 2008 年 8 月 24 日至 30 日在澳洲 Adelaide (阿德雷德)舉行。由於這個研討會具有極高的學術水準,世界各國知名的理論與應用力學學者皆會參與盛會。一般而言,每次 ICTAM 研討會皆有一千多篇重要的學術論文發表,而研討會也一向以嚴格審查投稿者的論文聞 名,審查通過的比率約只佔投稿論文篇數的六成而已,各國相關學者也以能在此研討會中發表論文為榮,同時它也是各國理論與應用力學研究實力呈現的機會與場所。

目前國際理論及應用力學組織(IUTAM)共有 49 個會員國,並有 17 個與力學相關 的國際學術學會隸屬在它底下,我國的「中華民國力學學會」為正式代表國內參與此國 際組織的學術性學會。中華民國力學學會於民國 69 年代表我國加入 IUTAM,成為 49 個會員國之一,這是國內極少數可以會員國的名義加入國際學術性組織的學會,目前並 由中華民國力學學會遴派兩位學者(台大機械系的馬劍清教授與清大動機系的王偉中教 授)參與 IUTAM 的理事代表大會,直接參加此國際組織重要決策的擬定,並為我國在國 際學術組織上發聲,因此由國內相關學者組成一個團隊共同參與 IUTAM 理監事會以及 ICTAM 2008 學術研討會實有其必要性,此舉除能增進國內研究人員與其他國家研究者 的互動外,也可促成國際合作,並爭取相關的學術研討會(通常稱為 IUTAM Symposia) 在我國舉辦。

由於 IUTAM、ICTAM 與國內力學學會之關係重要,我國力學學會理監事會先前即 決議協助成立一個團隊參加 ICTAM 2008,並確定團隊召集人由我國 IUTAM 理事代表 之一馬劍清教授擔任。在今年四月下旬研討會主辦單位完成投稿論文審查、並公布接受 論文名單後,馬教授即著手團隊成員的遴選工作,並於5月23日在台大應力所所召開 的第三十一屆理監事第三次聯席會議中,由馬劍清教授提出組團報告、確定團員名單, 並擬定工作時程表。本次國際理論及應用力學學術研討會(ICTAM 2008)共接受我國 29

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篇論文發表,馬教授在團隊成員的選定上,主要係參照國科會補助團隊參與國際學術學 會會議作業要點之各項規定,自 29 位國內參加本次研討會學者中,考量專門學識及研 究經驗、研究領域、年齡分佈及在研討會中擔任及可能擔任之任務等各方面條件來遴選 團隊成員,最後挑選馬劍清(台大、IUTAM 理事代表),王偉中(清大、IUTAM 理事代表), 朱錦洲(台大、資深流力學者),尹慶中(交大、中生固力學者),陳正宗(海大、中生固力 學者),楊龍杰(淡大、中生固力學者),潘國隆(台大、新生流力學者),楊馥菱(台大、新 生流力學者)等教授與筆者(中華民國力學學會前任秘書長、受邀發表論文並擔任 Session Chair)計九位組成團隊參與研討會。

在徵詢團隊成員同意加入團隊後,馬教授即負責與團員討論組團的各項事務、團 隊在會議中所扮演的角色和可能擔任之任務。最後於五月下旬收集團員相關資料並撰寫 組團規劃書及工作計畫報告書,由召集人馬劍清教授函送國科會提出組團申請。另外王 偉中教授因曾任國科會國際合作處處長、現任清大的國際長,所以亦很積極地聯絡澳洲 駐台代表處(澳大利亞商工辦事處-教育處)以及我國駐澳洲科技顧問組,協助安排本團順 道在 Adelaide、Melbourne 與 Sydney 參訪該三地區一些澳洲相關研究及學術單位,俾增 進雙方的了解、進行交流、並爭取合作之機會。而後,國科會並未核定馬教授所申請的 全部預算額度,僅補助團隊六十萬元,經衡量大家對於補助經費的需求,他決定他自己 與筆者自行尋求其他經費支付所需,而將以上補助經費分配至其他7名團員身上。筆者 因此事先向校方申請動用邁向頂尖大學計畫分配到系上的部份經費與校務基金(筆者過 去國科會計畫之結餘款)作為出國經費的來源,並獲得校方之事先核准。

二、參加研討會經過

緣上,筆者與馬劍清教授雖自行設法支付出國經費,但因係隨團參加國際研討會、 並隨團參訪澳洲的學術與研究機構,所以我們團員九人自出國至回國大抵皆係一起活 動,期間並偶而與我國參加該研討會的其他學者專家碰面並/或共同參與活動。依馬教 授事先向國科會所提的計畫書,團隊成員除了在研討會中發表各自的學術論文外,亦需 積極參與各項學術交流活動,並爭取相關 Symposia 在國內舉辦之可能性。馬教授所擬 定團隊召集人及團員所需肩負的主要任務包括:(一)由召集人馬劍清教授及王偉中教授 參加 IUTAM 大會各項正式會議及委員會,時間主要為8月26日晚上與8月27日下午; (二)積極與 IUTAM 大會中新任各項重要職務的學者聯繫,並評估邀請他們來台訪問之 可能性;(三)針對我國力學學會已爭取到、2009 年將於國內舉辦的 IUTAM Symposium on Recent Advances of Acoustic Waves in Solids 進行宣傳與邀稿;(四)爭取四年後在我國舉 辦與實驗力學有關 IUTAM Symposium 的可能性,特別向新任 IUTAM Symposium Panels 成員表達我國舉辦該類 IUTAM Symposia 之意願,並爭取與會 IUTAM 代表的支持;(五) 請王偉中教授參加 ICTAM 2008 期間在阿德雷德召開的 Beijing International Center for Theoretical and Applied Mechanics (BICTAM) International Advisory Panel (IAP)會議;(六) 依澳洲駐台代表處(澳大利亞商工辦事處-教育處)與我國駐澳洲科技顧問組的安排,參訪 澳洲相關學術研究機構,增加彼此相互了解,並爭取合作之機會;(七)責請團員積極參 與 ICTAM 2008 各領域之相關研討會場次,並要求大家於會議結束回國後,撰文將研討

會的過程與重要收穫在中華民國力學學會會訊上公開發表。

8/24 (週日)-8/30 (週六) ICTAM 2008 正式會議期間,我們團員除各自於排定的時段 前往宣讀、發表論文外,大致按照前段所提到的幾項要點行事。其中,在論文發表部份, 研討會主要將所有一千多篇的論文分為固體力學(簡稱「固力」)與流體力學(簡稱「流力」) 兩大部份,其中固力與流力各約佔論文篇數的 43%,固流互制者則約佔 14%。研討會 當局將所有論文安排成 OL (Opening Lecture)、CL (Closing Lecture)、BL (Batchelor Prize Lecture) · HL (Rodney Hill Prize Lecture) · FL (Fluid Mechanics Lectures) · SL (Solid Mechanics Lectures)、FSL (Fluids and Solids Sectional Lectures)與FM01-FM20、 SM01-SM20、FSM01-FSM09 等領域,於 13 個場地同時、平行的進行宣讀、發表,內 容幾乎包含所有力學領域,其中流力領域所頒授的 Batchelor Prize 與固力領域所頒授的 Rodnev Hill Prize 皆係 IUTAM 與 ICTAM 所首創者,並獲出版商提供部份經費贊助。以 上所有論文除特別演講外,一般人的論文大致被分配到前述所提流力 20、固力 20、固 流互制 9、合計 49 個主題項目裡發表,各主題項目又分別被排到 13 個場地,每個場次 有4-6篇論文被宣讀。而因時間與地點的安排不易,這些論文又被分為Lecture與Seminar 兩種形式發表,前者每篇論文由作者於 20 分鐘內宣讀並與聽眾討論完畢,後者每篇論 文則由作者以5分鐘的時間宣讀並與聽眾討論,另外再搭配事前與事後的海報張貼與解 說。綜合而言,以上整個論文發表流程相當繁複,但大會當局卻安排的相當順暢,值得 令人喝采與學習。

筆者所發表的論文題目為 Dynamic Analysis of Rail Vehicles and Investigation of Potential Derailment Caused by Wheelflats,被安排在 SM14: Multibody and Vehicle Dynamics 的主題項目內宣讀,該主題項目計有 28 篇論文發表,其中 7 篇以 Seminar 方 式發表,其餘則以 Lecture 方式發表。筆者被分配於 8/26 上午 10:40-12:40 的場次以 Lecture 方式宣讀以上論文,並有幸被邀請於 8/29 上午 09:15-10:35 的場次擔任場次主持 人(Session Chair),前者有六篇、後者則有五篇論文宣讀,一切皆相當順利地完成任務。 值得一提的是,筆者所主持的場次中,有一位德國 Stuttgart 教授、一位在美國 Lockheed 工作的博士、一位中國南京理工大學的教授、與兩位韓國 Ajou 大學的博士班研究生分 別發表、宣讀論文,該兩位韓國研究生所發表的論文內容及其宣讀效果皆相當不錯,令 人肯定,但問答、討論間則較無法掌握,所幸有其指導教授在台下幫忙補充釋疑。事後, 筆者與該指導教授寒暄,才瞭解他與筆者類似,係 1980 年代在美國 Iowa 大學獲得博士 學位,而後返回韓國任教迄今。相較於他目前的研究題目、研究能量與帶領所指導學生 出國開會的態勢,筆者自忖實不如他,至少筆者無法獲得足夠經費同時帶領兩位研究生 出國開會。

研討會依據預定進度於 8/29 下午兩點左右順利閉幕,閉幕典禮安排的節目包括 Closing Lecture、秘書處報告、前後任理事長交接、頒發獎狀與獎金予三位明日之星的 年輕學者等,並由新任理事長宣佈下屆 ICTAM 將於 2012 年在北京舉行。我們幾位教 授因係以團隊形式與會,所以大家全程參加閉幕典禮至禮成為止。

三、 學術研究機構參訪經過

如前所述,筆者此次除隨團前往 Adelaide 參與 ICTAM 2008、發表論文並主持一研

討會場次外,也在澳洲駐台代表處(澳大利亞商工辦事處-教育處)以及我國駐澳洲科技顧問組的安排下,於8月29日至9月4日期間隨團參訪 Adelaide、Melbourne 與 Sydney的一些學術與研究機構,進行交流並探詢學術合作之可能性。以下係我們團隊參訪行程的整理:

- (一)、 8/27 於 Adelaide 一澳洲駐台代表處(澳大利亞商工辦事處-教育處)事先租好 的旅館會議室與任教於 University of Melbourne 的 Professor Antoinette Tordesillas 會談、交流,探詢合作之可能性。
- (二)、 8/29 訪問位於 Adelaide 近郊 Mawson Lakes 的 University of South Australia 工學校區,主要是參訪 School of Advanced Manufacturing and Mechanical Engineering、Mawson Institute 與 Ian Wark Research Institute,並獲 Professors Rob Short、Roger Horn、Andrew Parfitt 等人及他們團隊的接待。筆者因留在 研討會會場主持一論文發表會場次,並未與會。
- (三)、 9/1 上午參訪位於 Melbourne 市區內的 University of Melbourne, 受到機械系 主任 Professor Doreen Anne Thomas 及其同仁的接待,並參訪該系重點實驗 室。
- (四)、 9/1 下午訪問位於 Melbourne 近郊 Highett 地區、澳洲科研機構 CSIRO (Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organization) 所屬之 Materials Science and Engineering 實驗室,由 Research Group Leader of Fluid Dynamics 之 Dr. Ilija Sutalo 及其同仁接待,並參訪相關實驗室。
- (五)、 9/2 參訪位於 Melbourne 市區邊緣之 ATSE (Australian Academy of Technological Sciences and Engineering)總部,由 Professors Mike Manton、Vaughan Beck、Terry Turney 等人接待,介紹 ATSE 及其相關之研究。
- (六)、 9/3 上午參訪位於 Sydney 郊區 West Lindfield 之另一 CSIRO Materials Science and Engineering 實驗室,由 Drs. Don Price、Mikhail Prokopenko 及同仁接待, 並參訪相關實驗室。
- (七)、 9/3 下午參訪 University of Sydney,並特別至 Faculty of Engineering and Information Technologies 與 Professors Yiu-Wing Mai、Liyong Tong、Roger Tanner、Steve Armfield、John Small、David Mckenzie、Timothy Langrish 等 人進行會談與交流。

謹將以上參訪行程列為本報告之附件,其詳細細節將可見於前述所提、參訪團隊 之集體報告中。
